- The costume does not reinforce jokes or stereotypes about certain groups, cultures or religions
- The costume does not involve a weapon of any kind
- The costume does not involve wearing a mask or face covering that would impede vision

Make sure to pack a change of clothes for your child so they can change out of their costume, if they choose to.
