New Business: Colleen Kaus

PRO Grant (Parent Reaching out Grant):

\$1000 fir the school to run an activity that helps school engagement with our families. Would like to start generating ideas for what we can do this year. We can circle back at our next meeting to see if any one has ideas. Can also look at previously approved projects for ideas.

In prior years we did: Math night, Guest speakers- safety in a digital age. We can also consider partnering with another school.

School Generated Funds: Kelly Dunford & Rachelle Martin

Brief explanation of what School Generated Funds are. It includes many things including supplies, copying, wages. The Board sets rules on how the school can enter in the information and how the funds can be spent. All funds generated must fall within the categories set out by the board.

The initial school budget is set on a per pupil ratio.

At times it may seem like our funds are high because there are amounts that are sitting in our account however the money is already spoken for but has not been sent out yet (could be for a variety of reasons).

We were in a deficit coming into this school year by 2-3 thousand but are doing okay.

Anticipated additional funds for this year include:

- 1. Mum Sale from the Phys Ed. Dept \$847 profit.
- 2. Poinsettia Sale anticipate \$800 (based on last years sales)
- 3. TCBY Frozen Yogurt Sale \$2000 (approximate amount last year)
- 4. Book Sale May & September \$5819 in scholastic dollars. (We use this for library books and class resources).

The school is continuing to fundraise for their technology. The fundraising goal for 2024/2025 is \$6645.00

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Pizza sales at the meet the teacher went well. School acknowledged this is something normally Home & School does. They appreciate Home & Schools support running these events in the past. This year the school decided to run it due to time and planning. They didn't want to burden Home & school due to the short notice.

Future budgeting consideration: Ancaster meadow is still looking into having a shade structure put in place in the back. Price ranges are about \$5,000-\$10,000.
