## CODE OF CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBLE USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES PROCEDURE

In May, HWDSB shared a message to families in response to Ministry of Education changes to the **Provincial Code of Conduct**. HWDSB will share the updated draft school board Code of Conduct in August before the first day of school.

Ahead of September 2024, all families can expect to receive an email message that clearly outlines expectations found in the following HWDSB policies and procedures:

- Code of Conduct Policy and Procedure
- Modern Learning Policy
- Responsible Use of Electronic Devices Procedure
- Student Behaviour and Discipline Policy
- Progressive Discipline and Promoting Positive Student Behaviour Procedure

All documents listed above will continue to be reviewed this fall. Students and families can expect changes to current DRAFT guidelines surrounding cellphones, vaping, social media and more. HWDSB will also be communicating new resources related to Caring and Safe Schools and Student Dress Guidelines before the start of the year.

## BUS TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY 2024 - 2025



If your child does not meet criteria for transportation a Courtesy Transportation Application form can be submitted to the school Principal. **As our school buses are reaching capacity, minimal to no Courtesy Transportation Applications will be approved.**

Possible approval may **begin October 2024**. An application form can be picked up at the office in September or completed on the Parent Portal. Please complete the form on-line or return a hard copy to the school office as soon as possible. **No courtesy riders will be allowed to ride the bus until October and only once approval with written permission from the Principal is granted.** Courtesy transportation is not granted on a first-come, first-serve basis as many factors are taken into consideration.

### WHAT DISTANCE DO I HAVE TO LIVE FROM MY DESIGNATED SCHOOL TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION?

Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board believes in providing the best possible learning environment for its students. This includes providing safe, secure and on time transportation to and from school for eligible students.

Students will be eligible for transportation services to their in-catchment school when the walking distance exceeds the following:

#### Elementary School

Kindergarten Students: 1.2 km  
Grade 1 – 8 Students: 1.6 km



#### Secondary School

Grade 9 – 12 Students: 3.2 km

**Parents of a child within the designated walking requirements have the primary duty of care to ensure the safe arrival of their child to school**

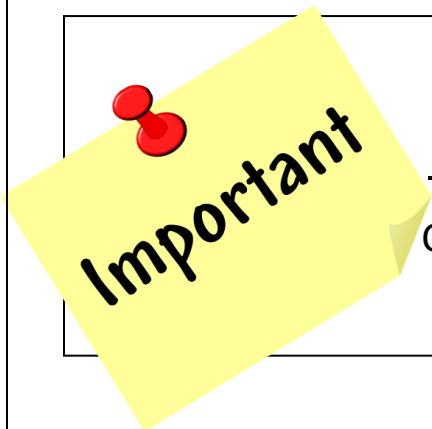
