Camp Power – For students **currently in Year 2 Kindergarten and Grade 1** – The goal of this camp is to support students in continuing to develop their **early reading and math skills** throughout the summer. teachers will lead engaging activities and facilitate inquiry, which build on specific skills and target the individual needs of all learners.

Camp CLIMB (Create Learn Inspire Motivate Believe) – For students **currently in Grade 2 to Grade 6** – The goal of this camp is to continue to build **literacy and math skills** throughout the summer. teachers will lead engaging activities and facilitate inquiry, which build on specific skills and target the individual needs of all learners.
