Dear Families and Students,

We are writing to let you know of a potential student planned and led walk out and protest taking place at Glendale Secondary School on Wednesday, May 29th in relation to the ongoing conflict between Israel and Hamas. The walkout is planned to happen during periods 3 and 4 (12:10 pm - 2:50 pm).

The walk out is being held by a group of students and the event has been promoted on social media channels.

While we support student voices, we also have an expectation that students attend class as scheduled. We ask students planning to leave class, to follow the school's regular attendance procedure. Parental permission for students under 18 years of age is required before signing out of class.

As these activities are not school or Board-organized events, there will be no staff supervision provided. As such, please note that student safety at this demonstration cannot be guaranteed by the school - however, we have arranged for security to be on site as a precaution.

Students are reminded that the media have the right to cover any event off school property. Please be mindful of speaking with the media. Anyone under the age of 18 should consult their parents/caregivers before speaking with a reporter.

HWDSB is deeply committed to upholding human rights for all and for creating an environment that is safe, inclusive, and respectful for all HWDSB students, staff and families. We do not stand with hate, intolerance, or violence of any kind. Students must not engage in any discriminatory, violent or harmful behaviour while participating in any protest or walk-out activity (and related social media activity). HWDSB's policies and procedures, including and not limited to, our Human Rights policy and Code of Conduct, are applicable. It is also possible that non-school community members may attend the protest, and anyone participating should prioritize their safe and well-being.
