## **Principal Report:**

- ROAR Assembly – Thursday December 5 at 11:10 am
- Candy grams have been changed to ensure inclusivity; these will now be sent anonymously and teachers will also be sending out to ensure all students receive one (donations can be made at the school)
- New updates to come to nurses' room; as this space is used for Lisgar visitors as a work space, the current 'bed' will be changed into a fold up bed to allow for more space for 'office' when needed
- Lisgar does not have a wheel chair accessible washroom, but this is long term goal. Currently making some modifications to make the washrooms more accessible in the interim
- Math groups with Ms. Hardy, Ms. Legere, Mr. Madjercic going well; reading programs to be run after Christmas
- Progress reports have gone out with opportunity for in person or phone interviews with teachers
- Recess guardians, Ms. Hardy is running the program and working with a new staff member; program falls under anti-bullying program
- Lunch monitors, not many volunteers
- class set of Ukulele's needed/wanted to promote the music program for the grade 3-5 students
- as we not have a dedicated music teacher, the board is re-doing the music room in the summer of 2025

## **Teacher Report:**

- Book Fair – profit of over \$1,600
- Mrs. Aldgate has purchased \$1,200 in books, about \$700 left to spend which includes a previous amount of \$400
- Indigo made \$9,400, Mrs. Santinon and Mr. Lutterotti will divide funds between teachers, to provide every teacher with the funds to develop library for their classrooms to help replenish the books; thank you letters will be sent
- in addition, each teacher will receive \$15 for free books, and will get 30% off for any other purchases from November 15 to March 31st
- Math facilitator applied for community grant and it was accepted, received \$500, use to purchase tools, for measurement; ie kitchen and bathroom scales to measure grams and kg, beakers and cylinders to measure volume
- Spirit of Giving underway with teachers
- DPA and gym balls are missing

- Krispy Kreme Fundraiser was a success, Lisgar sold 455 dozen and had a profit of \$1,820
