  - May need to buy and gather decorations earlier next year
  - Request is to hand out the chocolate bars at a different time or a different way next year
  - Games were well received. Will make minor changes to a couple games for next year

- ★ Dinner & Skate
  - Permits complete
  - Venue is now \$1883, up from about \$1300 in previous years
  - Optimist donated \$500
  - Bus is donated
  - Budget is \$2500
  - Still need food purchased, Ice Cream donated, ask Harvey's for stuffing, the farm to supply veggies
  - Get old/used crayons to Kat ASAP and she will make crayon shapes for DNS
  - Skate fitting went well bins well labelled for next year

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- ★ Go For Green
  - Looks great
  - Leaves stay on site
  - Got celandine away from the fence
  - Dug up garlic and a class made garlic bread with it
  - If the school keeps up with the garlic planting, will eventually make our own strain of garlic
  - Worked well to give Grade 5 bigger chores and Grade 2 the clean up
- ★ Pro Grant Update
  - Self Defense and Martial Arts
  - Up to 50 Adults can attend for 1.5 hrs
  - Will open to adults first but if not enough interest, could include kids
- ★ Food Drive & Tree of Warmth (Mitten/Hat/Socks) (mentioned in Principal Report) will run Dec 2-13

#### **Budget Update**

- ★ Balance of all Accounts \$12,756 + \$1687 still needing to be deposited from Halloween Dance = \$14,443
- ★ Funds paid for Go For Green, bus for Cross Country and halloween expenses
- ★ Outstanding Expenses (\$\$ set aside)
  - \$2000 for Dinner & Skate
  - \$1000 for the Playground Improvements
  - \$1500 for Playground Mulch (waiting for invoice)
  - \$1000 for DPA Equipment
  - \$822 for November Pizza
- ★ Minimum \$600 profit so far for Pizza and Booster Juice sales
- ★ Approx \$6960 Left as Available

## Fundraising

- ★ Purdy's already has \$1100 in sales which is \$300 profit. Due date to place orders is Nov 26. Delivery of items will be sometime between Dec 12-14 (TBD)
- ★ Discussed Gift Wrapping Fundraiser Idea
  - Gift wrapping day
  - Drop your gifts and paper and return later to pick up
  - No set price, would just ask for a donation
  - Would be adults only wrapping for privacy reasons
  - A demo for wrapping with fabric or napkins etc was suggested as an alternative to traditional paper wrapping
  - Idea was tabled until next year as there isn't enough time to organize it for this year

- ★ Lindsy motioned to spend \$200 on Cookies & Hot Chocolate before Winter break, 2nd - Laura, All in Favour

- ★ Donna motioned to spend \$1200 (12 Staff \* \$100 each) for consumables, 2nd -Lindsy, All in Favour
