



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Very Important Reminders:

PARKING

In order to keep all students, families and staff safe, we ask that you review the parking and drop-off/pick-up guidelines below:

- * **DO NOT ENTER** the main lane in front of the school. This is considered a fire lane and for BUSES ONLY at drop-off (9:00am–9:45am) and pick-up (3:30pm–4:20pm) times. (Pylons will be placed in the lanes to ensure safety)
- * If entering (outside drop-off and pick-up times) please follow the arrows if using the lane at the front of the building. Please do not enter through the NO ENTRY sign near the Daycare.
- * The designated parking lot is for **STAFF ONLY**. There is parking along the streets around the school for parents. Read signs posted to ensure you are parking legally.
- * Please remember that Accessible parking (at the side) is reserved for individuals with the appropriate permit. These spots are not to be used for idling or for brief stops. Under no circumstance should cars without the accessible parking permit use these spots. Please be respectful and model this when picking up your child/children.
- * Please be patient, at drop-off and pick-up as this can take 10-15 minutes depending on the weather. A reminder that our school grounds are open from 9:15am until 9:30am when our instructional bell rings. Teachers, Early Childhood Educators and Educational Assistants are ready to assist and support students during this time. As always, we encourage students who live close by to walk to school, this will cut down on the congestion in our parking lot.

PUNCTUALITY AND ATTENDANCE

We are writing again to all children's families to emphasize the importance of being at school on time and ensuring that students are receiving the required number of educational hours per day. There have been numerous incidents of some families routinely arriving at school past 9:30am or later and collecting their children very early before our end time of 3:50pm.

School starts at 9:30am every day. Children need to be in their class line at 9:30am so that they can start their lessons promptly.

Children who arrive late are greatly disadvantaged because they miss starting the day with their peers and the beginning of lessons. This means that they are often unsettled and confused about tasks. Their teacher will not always be able to re explain work.

It is also very important that children establish good routines and habits in preparation for the rest of their lives. Punctuality is a life skill that

they need to develop whilst they are young.

It is essential that you ensure that your child arrives at school on time to prevent disruption to your child's own learning and that of others. We are required to monitor children's punctuality and attendance.

On-going lateness is monitored by the school office and other agencies which have a duty to investigate further. We understand that there may be rare occasions when you are unavoidably late due to unforeseen circumstances which can be documented through the parent portal. Thank you for your continued support in ensuring that your child is reaching their full educational journey by bringing and picking up your child on time.

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
