- 1. Aldente Dentistry Award for Music Excellence (link to application) ~\$500

- 2. Chris Skinner Memorial Award (link to application) ~\$1000
  - This award is presented to a student who is:
    - actively involved in music either in the school or community
    - entering post-secondary school in the fall
- 3. Jeremi Lindstrom Memorial Award (link to application) ~\$500
  - This award is presented to a student who has demonstrated:
    - o independent learning skills, a positive attitude, a friendly demeanour and respect for others
    - o a thirst for knowledge, love of reading or interest in culture
    - interested in one or more of the following areas: literature, philosophy, history, politics, sociology, art, music or culinary arts
- 4. Jonathan Brown Memorial Award (link to application) ~\$1500
  - The award will be given to a graduating student who has demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
    - Preference will be given to a student who has faced health-related challenges such as cancer, chronic illness, personal injury, loss of a loved one.
