Each year, the Rotary Club of Waterdown presents several \$1,000 bursaries to students graduating from Waterdown District High School and pursuing post-secondary education. Cliff Lillicrop was an active member of our Club whose 3 children all graduated from WDHS, and we are pleased to remember him by giving his name to these bursaries.

The following criteria are considered for the awarding of the bursary funds:

- 1. Volunteer/community service activities, if any
- 2. Leadership experience, if any
- 3. Work experience, if any
- 4. Post-secondary education plans
- 5. Financial need (summary of existing funding and expected shortfall)

Note:

- Recipients must be a signed apprentice or accepted into a college/university program starting in September.
- Students pursuing post-secondary education part-time are normally not eligible for consideration.

Applicants are asked to submit a document, outlining their experiences and background as they relate to the bursary's criteria.
