#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (Grade 9 Students)**

- •1 **credit** in the arts
- •1 credit in health and physical education
- •1 credit in French as a second language
- •0.5 credit in career studies
- •0.5 credit in civics and citizenship
- •1 credit from the <u>STEM-related course group</u>

   Foundational Math Skills (Bridge course from Grade 9-10 Math
- If you earned a level 3 or below (70%) it is recommended to choose one of the above options to set up for success in MPM2D1.
