The process for determining the Student Trustees for the 2025 - 2026 Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board is in three parts:

- 1. Submission of completed Interest package by Wednesday, January 22nd, 2025 by 4 pm
- 2. Student Trustee Election Candidate video is due by Wednesday, February 5th, 2025 by 4 pm. Instructions and questions will be shared following receipt of Interest package.
- Student Trustee Election Candidate profiles will be posted to the website February 10th 14th, 2025.
- Election of the new Student Trustees will take electronically this year from February 18th 21st, 2025 all students in grades 7 12 will have an opportunity to vote for their top 2 candidates each school will submit a final ballot for their top 2 voted candidates as selected by the school population.

A final Board report will be submitted to the Board of Trustees for ratification in March 2025.

The new Student Trustees will be asked to attend the **Ontario Student Trustees' Association Conference** in **May 2025** along with the outgoing Student Trustees.

3. School Principal:

I acknowledge that this student will be a full-time student and may serve as a Student Trustee for the Hamilton-Wentworth District School Board from August 1, 2025 to July 31, 2026. and may, from time to time, be required to provide leadership and input outside of the regular classroom.

Please note that Student Trustees attend weekly meetings with the Board of Trustees on Monday nights from September to June. The length of time for these meetings vary, but generally start at 5 pm and end at 10 pm. Student Trustees also plan and attend monthly meetings for Student Senate and those meetings are generally held after school. Additionally, the Student Trustees are often asked to represent the student voice at special community events and provincial student conferences, and to be involved in select Board activities.

As part of the Student Trustee election process a picture of each candidate along with a written statement and a candidate video will be posted on the HWDSB public-facing website so that students can inform themselves before voting. In the video, the candidate will answer a question about the Student Trustee role and their vision. A signed Video Consent form is required before the candidate's information can be shared. Please see the Video Consent form for additional details.
